TECHNIQUE USED: Crochet



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

At widest points 7 1/2"/19cm x 68"/172.5cm

MATERIALS

Caron International's Simply Soft @Collection (100% Acrylic):

Shown in: #0005 Blackberry (A), 6oz;

#0012 Passion (B), 3oz

One Size I-9 (5.5mm) crochet hook or

size necessary to obtain gauge

Yarn needle

GAUGE

In single crochet, 10 sts = 4"/10cm

Each scallop of First Ruffle is approx

7 1/2"/19cm wide.

STITCHES USED

Single crochet (sc)

Treble crochet (tr)

Cluster (CL): Yo twice, insert hook in st indicated, yo, pull lp through, [yo, pull through 2 lps] twice, *yo twice, insert hook in same st, yo, pull lp through, [yo, pull through 2 lps] twice; rep from * once more, yo, pull through 4 lps on hook.

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Shell (Sh): {[Dc, ch 1] twice, dc} in st indicated.

NOTES

1. Gauge is not critical for this project.
2. To work in back loops of a stitch, work under the top loop of the stitch furthest from you, as it faces you.
3. To work in front loops of a stitch, work under the top loop of the stitch closest to you, as it faces you.

SCARF/COLLAR

First Ruffle

With A, ch 166.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each rem ch across, turn—165 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, working in back lps only, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 7: Rep Row 5.

Rows 8-9: Rep row 6.

Row 10: Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk first sc, dc in each of next 2 sc, *ch 1, dc in each of next 3 sc; rep from * across, turn—55 3-dc groups, 54 ch-1 sps.

Row 11: Ch 1, sc in first dc, sc in next dc, [ch 4, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc] twice, *sk 2 dc, [ch 1, tr] 6 times in next dc, ch 1, sk 2 dc, [sc in next dc, ch 4, sk 2 dc] 4 times, sc in next dc, rep from * 7 times more, sk 2 dc, [ch 1, tr] 6 times in next dc, ch 1, sk 2 dc, [sc in next dc, ch 4, sk 2 dc] twice, sc in next dc and in last dc, turn.

Row 12: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next sc, ch 4, *sc in next sc, sk next sc, [ch 2, tr in next tr] twice, ch 2, {[tr, ch 2, tr] in next tr} twice, [ch 2, tr in next tr] twice, ch 2, sk next sc, [sc in next sc, ch 4] twice, rep from * 7 times more, sc in next sc, sk next sc, [ch 2, tr in next tr] twice, ch 2, {[tr, ch 2, tr] in next tr} twice, [ch 2, tr in next tr] twice, ch 2, sk next sc, sc in next sc, ch 4, sc in next sc and in last sc, turn.

Row 13: Ch 1, sc in first sc, ch 4, sc in next sc, sk sc, *[ch 3, Cl in next tr] 8 times, ch 3, sk sc, [sc, ch 4, sc] in next sc, sk sc, rep from * 7 times more, [ch 3, Cl in next tr] 8 times, ch 3, sk sc, sc in next sc, ch 3, dc in last sc, turn.

Row 14: Ch 4, dc in ch-3 sp, *ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, {[sc, ch 3, sc] in next ch-3 sp} 7 times, ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, [dc, ch 3, dc] in next ch-4 sp, rep from * 7 times more, ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, {[sc, ch 3, sc] in next ch-3 sp} 7 times, ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, [dc, ch 3, dc] in next ch-4 sp, fasten off.

Second Ruffle

Row 1: With RS facing, join B with sl st to first unused lp of sc of row 5 of First Ruffle, ch 1, sc in unused of each rem sc, turn—165 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, working in front lps only, sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *sk sc, Sh in next sc, sk sc, sc in next sc, rep from * across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next Sh, rep from * across, ch 2, sc in last sc, fasten off.

Third Ruffle

With RS facing, join B with sl st to first unused lp of sc of row 7 of first Ruffle. Rep as for Second Ruffle.

FINISHING

Using yarn needle, weave in ends.

For best results, completely immerse in cool water and lie flat to dry.

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
